Optional Drop Zones

Hole # 1 – Drop Zone by fairway bunkers for ball hit into hazard

Hole # 4 – Drop Zone by corner of pond for balls hit into water hazard

Hole # 5 – We are playing in course out of bounds. A player must not drive his tee shot up # 4 fairway as it will be out of bounds

Hole # 5 – Drop Zone for balls hit into hazard on tee shot

Hole # 8 – the driving range fence on right is out of bounds as defined by split rail fence. The split rail fence that extends past the driving range is an immovable obstruction.

Hole # 10 – Out of bounds left is defined by white stakes and the white line that is on the paved path located left of the pine trees. The entrance road behind the putting green is out of bounds

Hole # 11 – Will have two optional drop zones . There will be a line painted on the cart path for balls entering the hazard on the right and tee side of line. And, if the player elects to use the additional option of the drop zone, they must drop the ball in the drop zone on the tee side of putting green. If the players ball enters the same hazard on the far side of the line and player elects to use additional option of the drop zone, they must drop the ball in the drop zone on the far end of the putting green.

Hole # 13 – Will have two drop areas . One drop zone on right is for balls hit into lateral hazard. Drop zone on left is for balls hit into lake in front of 12 tee. When playing hole 13 the lake on # 12 will play as a lateral hazard.

Hole # 15 – Drop Zone for balls hit into lake on hole 14 in front of putting green plays as a lateral hazard

Two drop zones are for balls hit into hazard over green , one on left and one on right by 16 tee area.
